Applicants are not to begin volunteering until they have been notified by the city and/or organization of their eligibility through the respective approved volunteer list and/or other designated method of notification. All volunteers will be given a picture identification card that must be worn at all times while coaching.

Specifically, I understand that any of the following convictions or pending charges including, but not limited to (1) Any felony during one's lifetime, (2) Any crime against children during one's lifetime and, or (3) any misdemeanor drug offense within the last ten years will disqualify me from serving as a volunteer or coach for the City of Acworth and/or the respective organizations. The City of Acworth reserves the right to reject any applicants based on the best interest of the city and/or the volunteer organization.

Mandated Reporting of a Child

- ☞ The law now requires all employees and volunteers that work with children to report suspected abuse or neglect of a child.
- ☞ The law took effect June 1, 2012 that includes volunteers to be considered Mandated Reporters.



What is your responsibility with this law?

- ☞ You must report any suspected child abuse to the proper authorities within 24 hours.
- ☞ You must have reasonable cause to believe a child has been abused.
- ☞ You are immune from criminal or civil liability if the report is made in good faith.
- ☞ You can be charged with a MISDEMEANOR if you FAIL TO REPORT ANY SUSPECTED CHILD ABUSE.



What types of abuse are there?

- ☞ Physical injury inflicted upon a child that is non-accidental
- ☞ Neglect or exploitation of a child
- ☞ Sexual abuse of a child
- ☞ Sexual exploitation of a child



What are indicators of physical abuse?

- ☞ Bite marks
- ☞ Scratches
- ☞ Welts
- ☞ Bruises in a pattern or that take on the shape of an item
- ☞ Fractures/Dislocations that are unexplained
- ☞ Bald spots on the scalp

**These do not always indicate abuse, but if frequent and unexplained, could be an indicator



What are indicators of neglect?

- ☞ Hoarding or begging for food
- ☞ Poor hygiene
- ☞ Inappropriate clothing or clothes do not fit
- ☞ Frequent and unexplained absences at events
- ☞ Unmet medical or emotional needs
- ☞ Inadequate supervision



What are indicators of sexual abuse?

- ☞ Difficulty sitting or walking
- ☞ Pain or itching in the genital area
- ☞ Inappropriate sexual overtones while playing
- ☞ Advanced knowledge of sexual activity
- ☞ Fear of people, places or specific activities
- ☞ Change in patterns of behavior and socialization



What is sexual exploitation of children?

- ☞ Any sexual activity involving a child in exchange for something of value
- ☞ This can include
 - ☞ Street prostitution
 - ☞ Pornography
 - ☞ Pimping
 - ☞ Escort Services
 - ☞ Internet-based exploitation



What should you do if a child discloses abuse?

- ☞ Stay calm
- ☞ Do not act visibly shaken or upset
- ☞ Praise the child for telling you
- ☞ Don't ask questions that are leading (example: "Did mommy do this to you?")
- ☞ Do not make any promises to the child (i.e. that you'll keep this a secret)



Who do you report abuse to?

- ☞ Baseball Association
 - ☞ Report Abuse to League Official on Board
- ☞ Football and Cheerleading Association
 - ☞ Report Abuse to League Official on Board
- ☞ Basketball League
 - ☞ Report Abuse to Recreation Coordinator
- ☞ Summer Camp Counselors
 - ☞ Report Abuse to Camp Director
- ☞ Horizon League
 - ☞ Report Abuse to Special Populations Coordinator



After the Report

- ☞ Please keep all reports confidential.
- ☞ Your obligated responsibility by law is complete.
- ☞ Don't treat children any differently.
- ☞ Don't forget boundaries when volunteering, especially with social media.
